Within her role, Katherine regularly attended court alongside counsel on cases in the Family Courts and High Court. Additionally, Katherine worked directly with clients, drafting witness statements, conducting meetings and dealing with client enquiries. In this role, Katherine has developed an empathetic yet firm approach to working with clients. In addition to her paralegal responsibilities, Katherine also represented clients at pre-proceedings meetings, where she discussed the written agreement with the clients and then advocated for them during and after the meeting.

Katherine also has a keen interest in working with victims and alleged perpetrators of domestic violence, having worked and continuing to volunteer with the Herts Domestic Abuse Helpline for a number of years.
