Following this he also spent a number of months working at the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions in Fiji, preparing respondent submissions in major appeal cases.

He is a practising Attorney (Texas) and undertakes a variety consulting work primarily in the field of construction health and safety, while his U.S. legal practice primarily consists of employer's liability and construction law.

Hamilton Eddy speaks German fluently and in light of his multi-jurisdictional experience, welcomes matters of an international nature.

As a keen shooting sports enthusiast, he is familiar with all aspects of firearms law and currently sits on the Executive Committee of the UK delegation of the Conseil International de Chasse (CIC).
